Kristine Beckley serves as Acting General Counsel at the California Complete Count – Census 2020 Office (Census Office). Beckley provides legal services to the Census Office and the California Complete Count Committee on all legal matters related to California's statewide effort to achieve an accurate and complete count in the 2020 Census.

Beckley is on loan to the Census Office from the Franchise Tax Board (FTB), where she is a Tax Counsel IV. From 2016 to 2018, Beckley served in FTB's Litigation Bureau where she worked on administrative and contract matters. Prior to her work at FTB, Beckley served as Senior Staff Counsel at the Employment Development Department (EDD) from 2006 to 2016. At EDD, Beckley helped implement an automated and modernized system for the audit, collection, and accounting of employer taxes. She also helped implement EDD's transition from paper checks to an electronic benefit payment system. At EDD, Beckley received a Superior Accomplishment Award for her services. In addition, she successfully litigated numerous cases before the State Personnel Board, the California Department of Human Resources, and the Unemployment Insurance Appeals Board.
