Mignonne Pollard serves as Education and Schools Outreach Manager at the California Complete Count – Census 2020 Office. Pollard is responsible for a \$7.45 million budget that includes forty County Offices of Education contracts and partnerships with University of California, California State University, and the Foundation for Community Colleges. She also supports the LGBTQ population of California as the liaison to the statewide partner, Equality California.

She served as an Education Programs Consultant representing the California Department of Education in Los Angeles county working with over 80 school districts and multiple community-based organizations. She provided direction for afterschool programs on program implementation, policies, and procedures. As the Assistant Director of Programs, Policy, and Outreach for California's 4-H Youth Development Program, she led national and statewide teams. As chairperson of the National 4-H Curriculum System, she guided changes in curriculum production and distribution. At the New England Equity Assistance Center at Brown University, she co-founded Rhode Island's African American Educators Network. She earned a Doctor of Education from Harvard University, Graduate School of Education; a Master of Arts degree in Urban Affairs and Policy Analysis from the New School University in New York City. Her Bachelor of Arts degree is in Spanish/Latin American Studies from Flagler College, St. Augustine, Florida.
