Prior to this role, she served as Regional Program Manager – Northern California Lead for the Census Office. She brings over 30 years of experience working with philanthropic and human rights organizations to develop innovative, inclusive, and results-oriented programs. She has worked at the Disability Rights Fund, where she facilitated strategic partnerships and raised awareness to advocate for the rights of people with disabilities worldwide. She has also managed global programs at the World Bank, focusing on civic engagement, Indigenous Peoples rights, and NGO capacity building at a time of emerging relations between the Bank and civil society. She has a certificate from the World Bank International Program for Development Evaluation and a master's from the Yale School of Management and a bachelor's from Lewis and Clark College.

She is a Returned Peace Corps Volunteer from Senegal, past Co-Chair of the Board of Directors of the International Funders for Indigenous Peoples, and a Trustee of the World Affairs Council of Northern California. She is also a member of the APIs Rise Fund, which seeks to increase API philanthropy in the Sacramento region.
